We would expect the successful candidate to possess the following qualifications, experience and competencies:

- An Education Degree or other teaching qualification (preferably a post graduate degree) with specialisation in Foundation Phase and early childhood development;

- Preferably a **successful track record of teaching Foundation Phase** for a minimum of 5 years at an advanced level, whilst having taught English as a Second/Additional Language to non-English speakers (in this case German speaking students);
